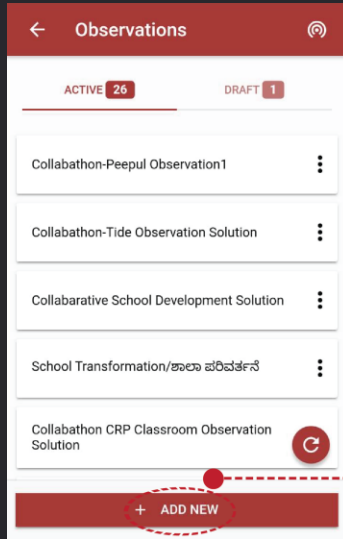

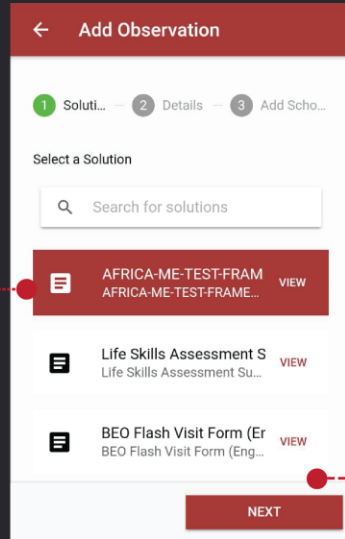
The steps to add a new observation form is simplified.

A possible use case:

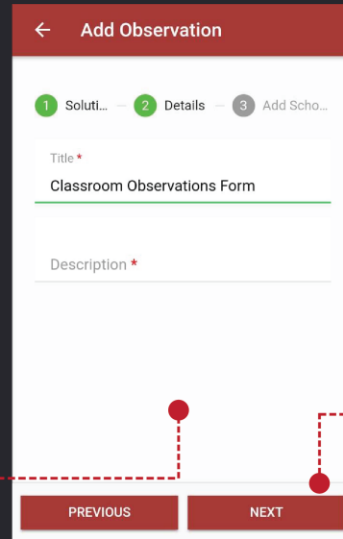
As an observer if you want to add an observation form, you can do in three simple steps



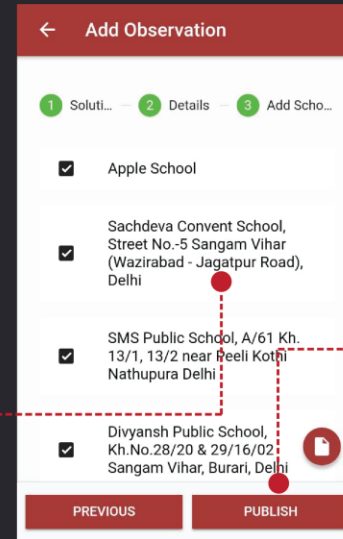
Open Observations,
click on add new



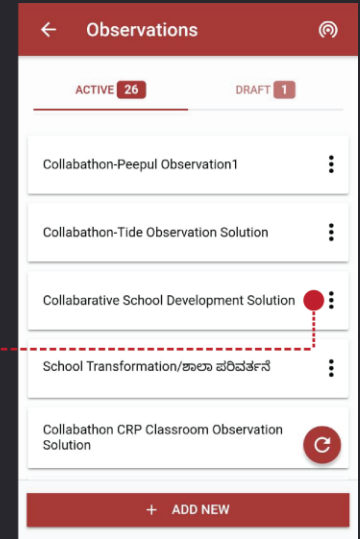
Select the form you

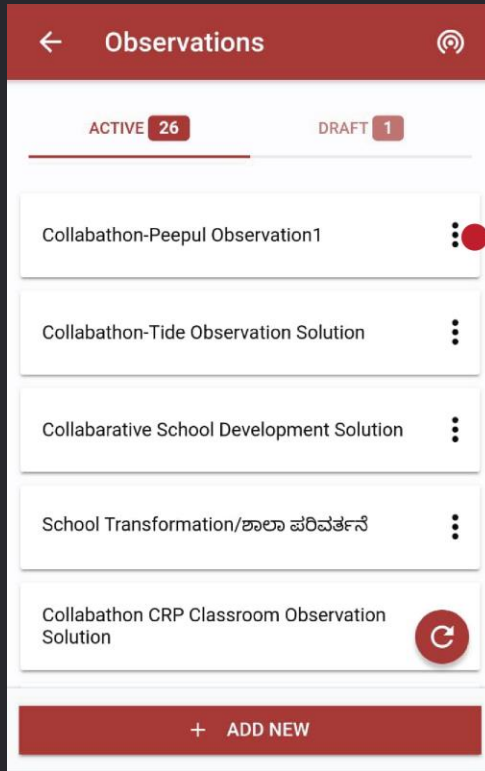

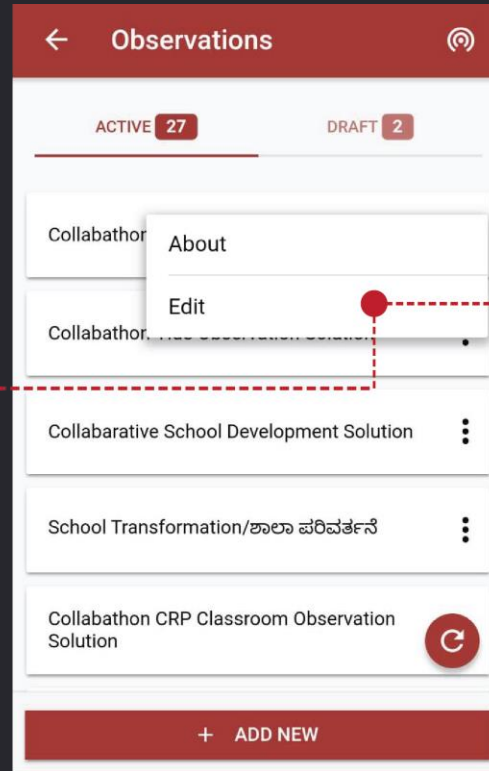
A description about the observation form is now available along with the name in about section

A possible use case:

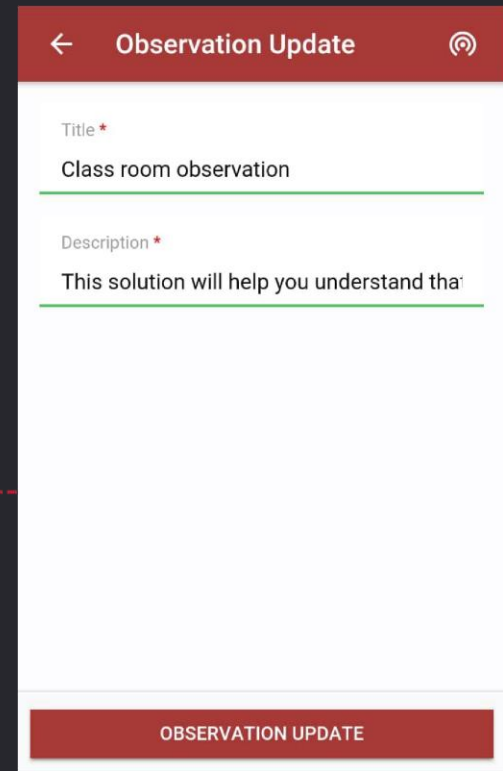
An observer can see the description about the form along with the meta-data which will indicate the start and end date.

Voice-over to question and responses

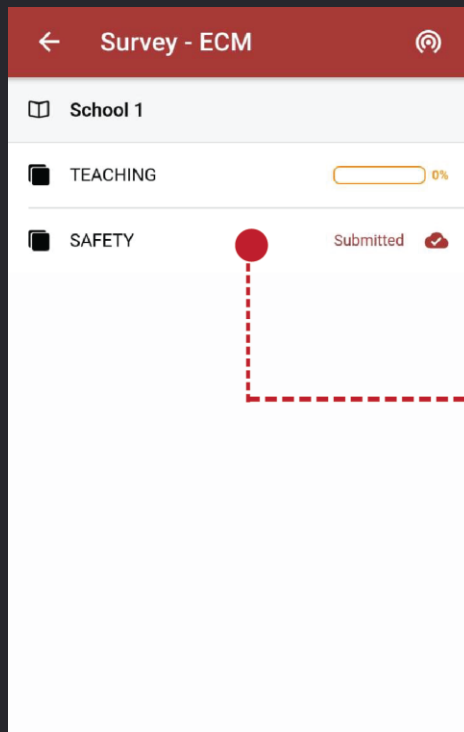

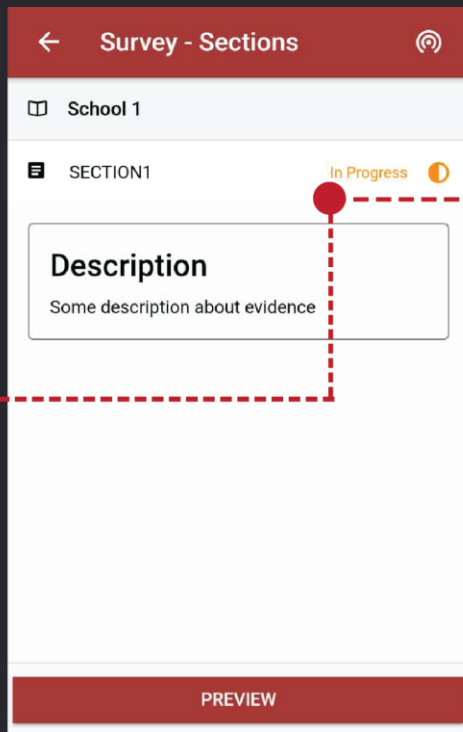
With this upgrade an audio feature has been added which will read out the question and options.

A possible use case:

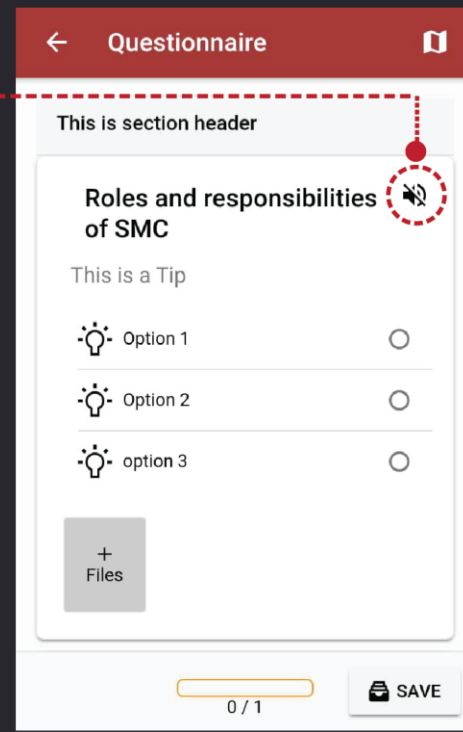
As a user you can now listen to the questions and its options and then choose the most relevant answer.

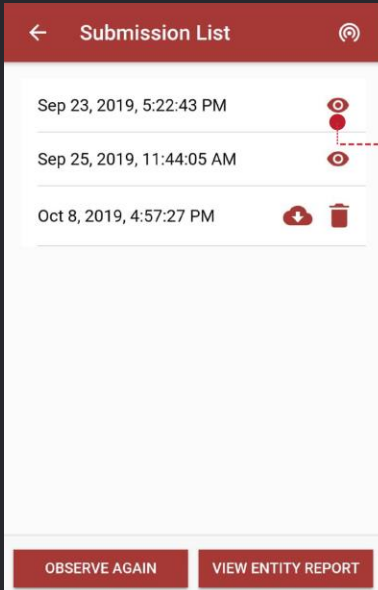

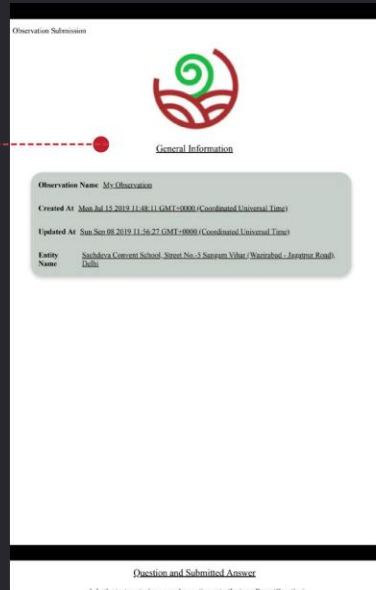
With this new upgrade you can access reports of individual observation made or a collated report of multiple observations.

A possible use case:

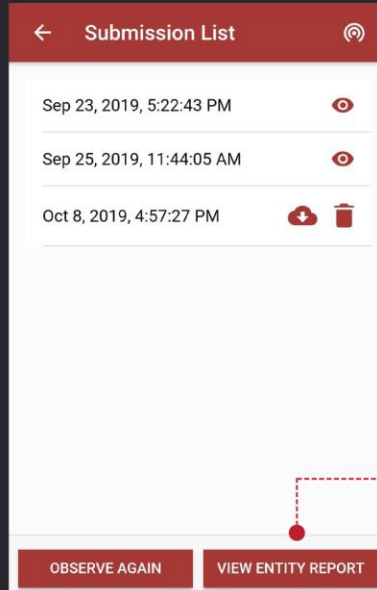
As an observer you can now access reports of individual observation made or a collated report of multiple observations to find patterns in the data collected to plan better for your school



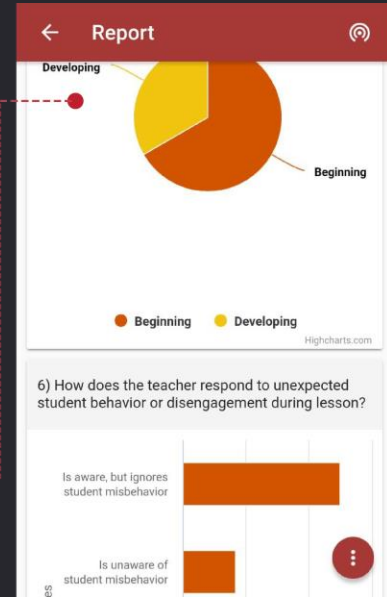
Open the schools and click on the 'view observation report'



Once you click on it you will see the report of one observation



Open submission list and click on the 'view entity report'



Once you click on it you will see a collated report of all observations

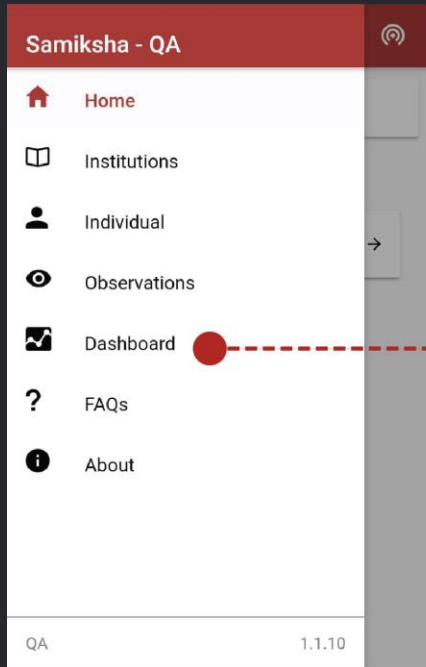

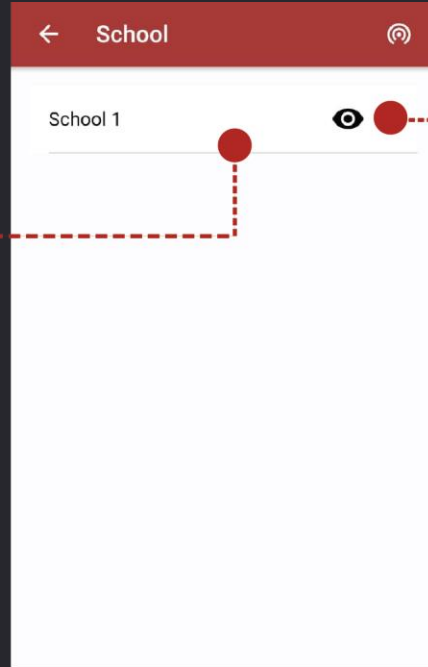
With this upgrade a new feature called 'Dashboard' has been added, which will open a window which shows different assessment reports

A possible use case:

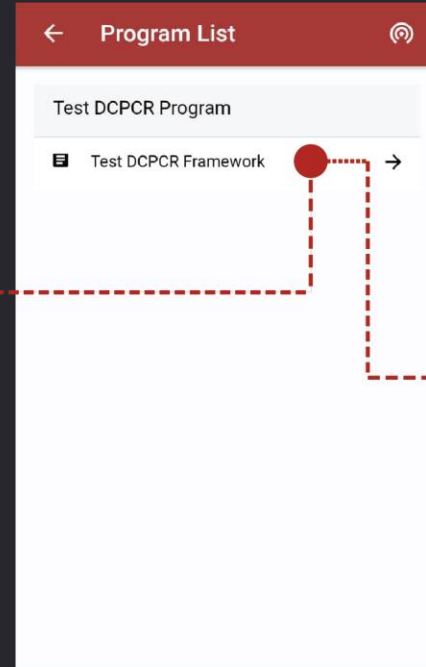
As an assessor you can now see the reports of your assessments which will give you a clear picture of the progress of the school for which the report has been created.



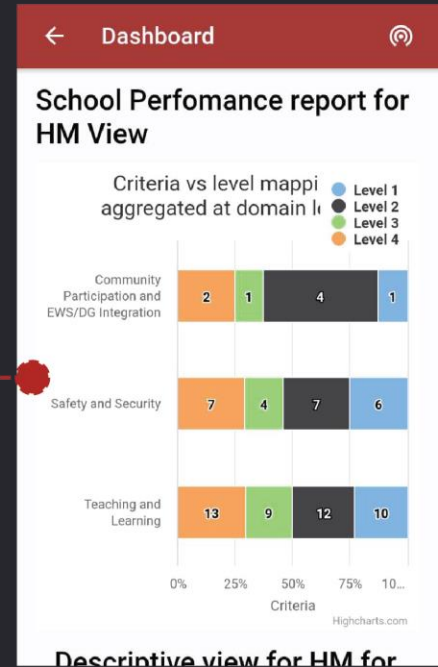
Click on the menu bar and select Dashboards
